TOTAL NUMBER OF IDPS CURRENTLY DISPLACED









All information collected on IDPs and returnees is included in the Emergency Tracking (ET) database once the locations of displacement or return have been identified and validated. The identification of the locations of displacement of the new arrivals requires some time, especially in out-of-camp locations. As some areas are not easily accessible, time is required between an actual population movement and its tracking and reporting.

As of June 12:

- Haj Ali camp recorded an increase of 203 IDP families;
- The newly opened Qayyarah Jad'ah 6 camp recorded an increase of 1012 IDP families;
- Hasansham U3 camp and Hasansham M2 (former Khazer M2) recorded an overall increase of 101 and 145 IDP families respectively;
- Return movements are reported from camps in Merkaz Hamdaniva sub-district.
