



	57 INDs left Bama camp to Pulka in Gwoza LGA. 70 INDs left Bama to Maiduguri M.C. LGA. 13 INDs left Bama camp to Muna Garage, Jere LGA.	
	<i>Banki Town:</i> 30 INDs arrived from Bula Umarye in Kumshe, Bama LGA. 42 INDs arrived from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA. 4 INDs arrived from Dusuman ward of Jere LGA. Needs include shelter, food and NFI. WHO provided medical intervention.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Chibok	5 INDs arrived at Mboa, Wuntaku ward in Chibok, from Wavi, Gumsuri ward of Damboa LGA. Needs include NFI, shelter and food. 45 INDs left Mbalala to Mubi and Askira Uba LGAs in Adamawa State due to lack of shelter in Mbalala.	ST/ LG

STATE: Borno LGA: Gwoza	<i>Gwoza Town:</i> 188 INDs escaped from Boko Haram in Shiyadawe and Lakwadisa community in Gwoza and 27 INDs were rescued during military operations within Kuranabasa/Ngoshe Sama Ward in Gwoza LGA. MSF and WHO immunized children and also provided food and NFI support. 369 INDs returned to Gwoza town from Samu Naka, Mubi North and Mubi South in Adamawa State. 42 INDs arrived at Gwoza town from Bakassi camp in Maiduguri M.C. LGA. <i>Pulka Transit Camp:</i> 62 INDs arrived at Pulka Transit camp from Bama IDP camp. 3 INDs arrived at the camp from Kirawa in Cameroon. 12 INDs arrived at the camp from Bakasi camp in Maiduguri. 2 INDs arrived at Pulka from Agapalwa ward, Gwoza LGA. Needs include food, water, shelter and NFI.
STATE: Borno LGA: Kala Balge	156 INDs arrived at Rann "A" from Sigal ward in Kala Balge LGA. 24 INDs arrived from Kumaga Kalma of Kalabalge LGA. 11 INDs returned from Bodo in Cameroon.
STATE: Borno LGA: Kukawa	13 INDs returned to Doro Baga from Jaga in Kebbi State. 8 INDs returned to Bagadaza community in Baga from Gamboru Liberty in Maiduguri M.C.
STATE: Borno LGA: Mafa	17 INDs arrived at Government Lodge from Goni Kachalari Dusuman ward of Jere LGA. 10 INDs arrived at Hausari from Agalti Ajiri ward of Mafa LGA due to poor living condition in Ajiri ward. 13 INDs arrived at IDP Camp B from Dawunba Gawa ward of Mafa LGA due to attacks by Boko Haram.
STATE: Borno LGA: Monguno	34 INDs arrived at Government Science Senior Secondary School Monguno from Baga in Kukawa LGA.13 INDs left Monguno to Aligumbori of Guzamala LGA to engage in farming as a means of livelihood.
STATE: Borno LGA: Ngala	49 INDs arrived at International School Camp from Muktu, Ndufu ward. 39 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala from Wurge ward in Dikwa LGA. 166 INDs arrived at International School camp Ngala from Ndufu ward of Ngala LGA. 69 INDs arrived at Ngala from Zannari, Wulgo Ward of Ngala LGA.
STATE: Borno LGA: Konduga	17 INDs arrived at Boarding Primary School camp from Yale ward of Konduga LGA due to military operation in Yale.
