



On 31 December:

- Approximately 350 families arrived to Hasansham M2 (former Khazer M2) camp from Markaz Mosul and Markaz Tilkaif sub-districts;
- The increase reported in Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site is due to further data validation;
- Approximately 1 family arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 camp while 4 families left.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people

displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
