



Summary

Askira/Uba (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 48 new arrivals and 13 departures were recorded in Askira/Uba during the reporting period. These include 32 individuals (INDs) who arrived at the town from Adamawa, 13 INDs who arrived from neighbouring wards in Askira, 3 INDs who arrived from Maiduguri M.C. and 13 INDs who left for Gwoza LGA.

Bama (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 45 INDs arrived at Bama town and 7 INDs left Bama during the reporting period. These include 28 arrivals at Kumshe/Nduguno, 17 arrivals at Kasugula and 7 INDs who left Kasugula for Maisandari in Maiduguri M.C.

Damboa (Trigger: poor living conditions): 6 INDs arrived at Abori Gate Camp and 2 INDs arrived at Central Primary School Camp Damboa during the reporting period. The arrivals were from neighbouring communities in Damboa.

Dikwa (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 33 INDs arrived at Dikwa 20-Housing Estate from Mallam Kari in Gulumba ward of Bama LGA.

Gwoza (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 558 INDs arrived at Gwoza during the reporting period. These include 53 new arrivals at Wege Arrival Centre in Pulka, 478 arrivals at Wakane, 16 arrivals at Hausari and 11 arrivals at Gadamayo community.

Kukawa (Triggers: poor living conditions, improved security): 81 INDs arrived at Kukawa town during the reporting period. These include 42 INDs who arrived at Bumdumari community from Bunza Marafa in Kebbi State, 13 INDs who arrived at Ajari community from Konduga, 10 INDs who arrived at Yoberi community from Maiduguri M.C., 8 INDs who arrived at Kauwa/Malamti community from Monguno and 8 INDs who arrived at Pompom Gajagaja community from Kafin Hausa in Jigawa.

Madagali (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 40 INDs arrived at Madagali town from neighbouring wards, 7 INDs left the town for Mubi South LGA and 3 INDs left for Babel ward in Madagali LGA.

Mafa (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 22 INDs arrived at Mafa during the reporting period. These include 16 INDs who arrived at Government Girls Secondary School (GGSS) Camp from Maiwa community in Mafa and 6 INDs who arrived at Mafa Primary School Camp from Jere LGA.

Maiduguri M.C. (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 1 IDP arrived at Bakasi Camp from Gwoza and 49 INDs left the Camp voluntarily for Wakane community in Gwoza LGA.

Michika (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 54 INDs arrived at Michika and 13 INDs left Michika during the reporting period. These include 19 INDs who arrived from Yola South LGA, 17 INDs who arrived from Gombi LGA, 11 INDs who arrived from Jos in Plateau and 13 INDs who left Hausari community for Gulak in Madagali LGA.

Monguno (Triggers: Military operation, poor living conditions): 14 INDs arrived at GGSS Camp Monguno from Marte LGA and 3 INDs left GSS Monguno for Minna Central, Chanchaga, Niger State.

Mubi-North (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 14 INDs left Mayobani community in Mubi-North for Wakane ward of Gwoza LGA.

Ngala (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 123 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala during the reporting period. These include 93 INDs who arrived from neighbouring wards in Ngala, 19 INDs who arrived from Cameroon and 11 INDs who arrived from Ibadan in Oyo State.

Jere (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 6 INDs arrived at Muna Moforo Camp in Dusuman ward of Jere LGA from Ala ward of Marte LGA.

Kaga (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living conditions): 4 INDs arrived at NRC Camp in Benisheikh from Afa village in Kaga.

Kala Balge (Trigger: poor living conditions): 3 INDs (returnees) arrived at Rann IDP site in Kala Balge from Mokolo in Cameroon.

Konduga (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 4 INDs left Boarding Primary School Camp Konduga for Maisandari in Maiduguri M.C. LGA.
