



WEST ANBAR CRISIS DISPLACEMENT OVERVIEW

19.12.2017

62,910 IDPs transited through Kilo 18 and Hammam al-Aleel screening site since January 2017

68,484 IDPs displaced from west Anbar since January 2017 and identified at their location of displacement, of these:

46,356 IDPs currently registered in camps

22,128 IDPs identified in out-of-camp locations:

21,366 IDPs in private settings

762 IDPs in critical shelter

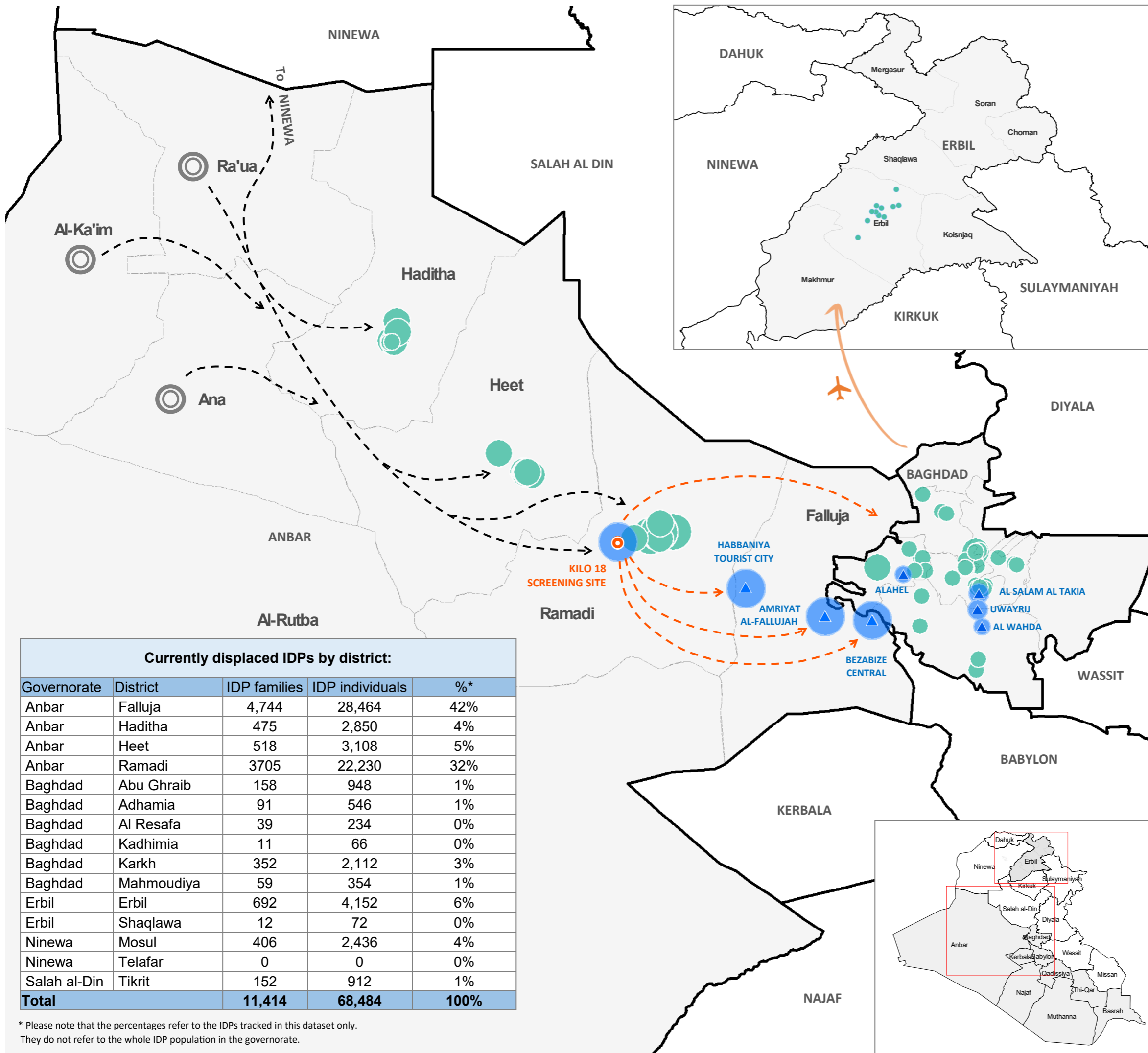
To date, there are 2,766 returnees from this crisis

DTM has been monitoring displacement movements from west Anbar governorate, particularly the districts of Ana, Al Ka'im and Ru'a, since January 2017. ISF operations to retake ISIL's last strongholds in west Anbar intensified in September and finished in November. As most IDPs transit through Kilo 18 and Hamman al-Aleel screening sites, DTM has activated a flow monitoring system for these two sites, in addition to the core DTM methodology of identifying IDPs at their location of displacement and return.
