










IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of origin or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, causes of displacement, geography and needs. It also tracks returnees who returned to their location of origin.

During the reporting period, between 12 and 18 December 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 514 households (3,084 individuals) displaced at least once. Conflict was the main reason for displacement, accounting for 98 per cent (504 HH) of the total, followed by economic reasons, accounting for two per cent (10 HH).

From 01 January 2021 to 18 December 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 24,335 households (HH) (146,010 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once.

Some 896 HH displaced in the previous reporting period, which covered 05 December - 11 December 2021, in the governorates of Marib (858 HH), Ad Dali (16 HH), Al Hodeidah (12 HH), Taiz (8 HH), and Aden (2 HH), were only identified in the current period and so, this figure has been added to the cumulative displacement total recorded from the beginning of the year.


