





> Affected and Displaced Persons by type of natural disaster



Data presented in this dashboard was collected by Red Cross volunteers during the period of October 2018 to December 2019 within 24 hours of the emergency incident. All emergency situations that occur in the country are not taken into account by the DTM emergency tracking tool. Emergency situations taken into account are incidents that cause significant damage and require an immediate response from the humanitarian community, or that cause displacement of the population. Only severe emergency events are weekly published.
