



## Context and methodology

For more than 5 years, Chad and others countries of the Lake Tchad Bassin have been the targets of attacks by armed groups that have caused internal and cross-border population displacements. In Chad, IOM is implementing the Displacement Tracking Matrix since May 2015 in the Lac province to gather updates on the number and needs of displaced populations due to this crisis, in order to guide humanitarian and development programs. Data are collected from key informants in villages and sites hosting these people. This dashboard presents results of evaluations carried out between August and September 2019 in 184 locations.


