The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to quickly collect information on sudden displacements of populations. Information is collected through key informant interviews and direct observation. This dashboard provides information on events which occurred on 24 and 25 May 2019, affecting two sites and two villages in the Lac province. Data was collected from 24 to 27 May 2019.

SUMMARY OF EVENTS

Following an armed attack on the village of Tchokorada (départment of Fouli, souspréfecture of Liwa) on 23 May 2019, 72 households of 300 individuals fled to the village of Kangou, also located in the Liwa sous-préfecture.

Following an armed attack on the village of Gomirom Doumou, located on an island of lake Chad (in the département of Mamdi, souspréfecture of Bol) on 23 May 2019, 1,002 households of 4,185 individuals from several villages on the island (including: Tchoukouli, Ngalimia, Kangara, Bougouroumi and Barerom) fled the island by boat towards the mainland. Among displaced villagers, 120 households (500 individuals) fled to the site of Kaya, 144 households (600 individuals) to the village of Kallinga and 738 households (3.085 individuals) to the site of Koudouboul. All are located in the sous-préfecture of Bol. Because armed attacks on the islands of the Lake Chad have becoming more frequent in recent days, displacements from the islands to the mainland are likely to grow in scale.


