SUMMARY OF EVENTS

On 17 June 2019, 40 households composed of 102 individuals left the village of Kalidoua, located on the mainland in the sous-préfecture of Bol (Mamdi Department) to return to their village of Ngalamia, located on an island of Lake Tchad. They had previously left their village for security reasons and had found shelter on the mainland in Kalidoua. Key informants indicated that these return movements were triggered by the deployment of security forces to the islands of Lake Chad and the ensuing improvement in security conditions.

On 19 June 2019, 390 households composed of 817 individuals left the site of Maar, located in the sous-préfecture of Bol (Mamdi department) to return to their village of Selia, located on an island of Lake Chad. They had previously left their village for security reasons and had found shelter on the mainland. Key informants indicated that these return movements were triggered by the deployment of security forces to the islands of Lake Chad and the ensuing improvement in security conditions.
