Information is collected through key informant interviews and direct observation. This dashboard provides information on events which occurred from 24 to 29 June 2019 in 2 sites and 1 village in the Lac province.

SUMMARY OF EVENT


Between 24 and 29 June 2019, 306 households composed of 1,200 individuals left the Kindjiria-Gana located in the Fouli department (Sous-prefecture of Kaiga-kindjiria) which had been attacked on 22 June 2019, to settle in the site of Kilikara, the village of Kaiga-Kindjiria and the site of Ngore I, all located in the sous-préfecture of Kaiga-kindjiria. This movement came as a result of the authorities' recommendations that residents leave the Kindjiria-Gana site due to insecurity in the surrounding area.
