



SUMMARY OF EVENT

Following floods that took place on 23 September 2019 in the village of Chicheme (located in the sous-préfecture of Korbol, département of Barh-Kôh), 40 households of 271 individuals left for the villages of Eden, Ben Said and Ndor-Adji, located in the same sous-prefecture, and to the village of Madane located in the sous-préfecture of Goundi (Département of Goundi, province of Mandoul).

Following an armed attack on 26 September 2019 in the village Kondel (sous-préfecture of Kaiga-Kindjiria, département of Fouli), 130 households of 931 individuals had to leave the site of Ngorea 1 for a newly created site, named Magui 2, located in the same souspréfecture.
