
# **SUMMARY** OF MOVEMENTS


Arrivals: 4.929 individuals


**Departures: 481 individuals** 

Within the period of 17 to 23 April 2018, a total of 5,410 movements were recorded, including 4,929 arrivals and 481 departures at locations in Askira/Uba, Bama, Biu, Chibok, Damboa, Demsa, Dikwa, Fufore, Girei, Gombi, Guzamala, Gwoza, Hawul, Hong, Jere, Kaga, Kala/Balge, Konduga, Kukawa, Madagali, Mafa, Magumeri, Maiha, Michika, Mobbar, Monguno, Mubi-North, Mubi-South, Ngala, Numan, Yola-North and Yola-South LGAs of Borno and Adamawa States.

The main triggers of movements were voluntary relocation (40%), poor living conditions (31%), improved security (12%), ongoing conflict (9%), military operations (5%), fear of attacks (1%), involuntary relocation (1%) and beginning of farming activities (1%).







#### **Summary of major movements**

Gwoza: 1,168 arrivals were recorded in Gwoza Local Government Area (LGA) during the reporting period. These include 588 new arrivals at the Transit Camp in Pulka, 515 arrivals at Wakane community and 65 arrivals at Gadamayo community. The movement triggers include voluntary relocation, poor living conditions and ongoing conflict.

Bama: 806 arrivals were recorded in Bama LGA during the reporting period. These include 348 arrivals at Banki Camp from Kumshe and Gulumba wards of Bama, 76 arrivals at Banki Camp from Cameroon and 382 arrivals at GSSSS Camp. The movement triggers include military operations in the area, improved access/security and voluntary relocation.

Ngala: 654 arrivals were recorded at Ngala LGA during the reporting period. These include 410 arrivals from Marwa in Cameroon, 54 arrivals at International School Camp from Wulgo ward of Ngala due to recent conflict in the area, 90 arrivals at International School Camp from Kala/Balge LGA, 42 arrivals at International School Camp from Dikwa LGA, 43 arrivals at Arabi Camp from Dikwa and 15 arrivals at Gamboru community from Jere (10 individuals) and Maiduguri (5 individuals) LGAs.

Jere: 555 arrivals were recorded at Jere during the reporting period. These include 307 arrivals at Old-Maiduguri ward from Baga in Kukawa LGA, 216 arrivals at Old-Maiduguri from Marte LGA and 32 arrivals at Dusuman ward from Dikwa LGA. The movements were triggered by poor living conditions.
