100+ migrants intercepted by Mauritanian coast guards in Nouadhibou before departure to the Canary Islands

Migrant Presence exercise completed in Nouadhibou, Mauritania's second-largest city. Approximately **32,000 migrants** from sub-Saharan Africa identified in the city.

Following the collapse of a gold mine in Kouri region, **74 individuals** (67 Chadian nationals and 7 Sudanese nationals)

Border closures between Niger and Nigeria are slowing down migrant flows as well as goods and services trades (Zinder)

Following a violent outbreak in Kondel (Fouli), nearly **1,000 IDPs** moved to a new site (Magui2)

2019 Regional Mobility Mapping published for West and Central Africa

8,207 individuals movements recorded in North Est Nigeria. These movements were primarily triggered by conflict or voluntary relocations

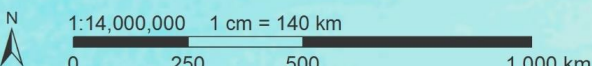
New displacement figures available for North East Nigeria. **2,018,512 IDPs** (does not include Middle Belt) identified by DTM

New displacement figures available for Far North Cameroon. **270,870 IDPs** identified by DTM
