In camps/camp-like settings:



26% of IDPs are women.



19% of IDPs are men.



30% of IDPs are girls.



25% of IDPs are boys.



22% of IDPs are children under 5 years.



7% of IDPs are nursing mothers.



45% of IDPs have been previously displaced.



67% of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.



4% of IDPs complained of not having potable water.



54% of IDPs cited blanket/mat as the most needed NFI.



67% of education facilities are located off-sites.



61% of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.



12% of IDPs do not have access to regular medication.



19% of IDPs do not have access to food support.

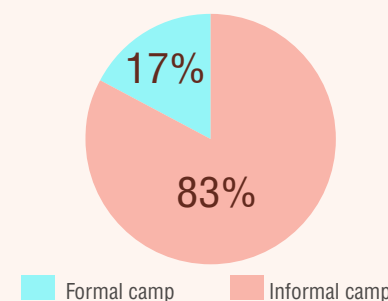
In 90% of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.



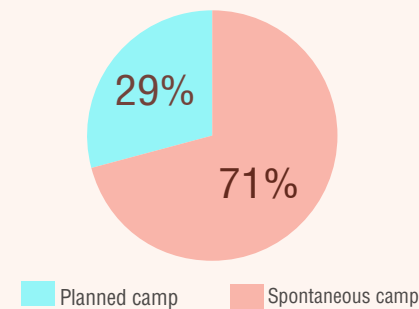

Sites number by status



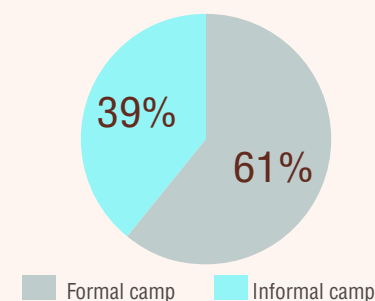
Sites by classification
