

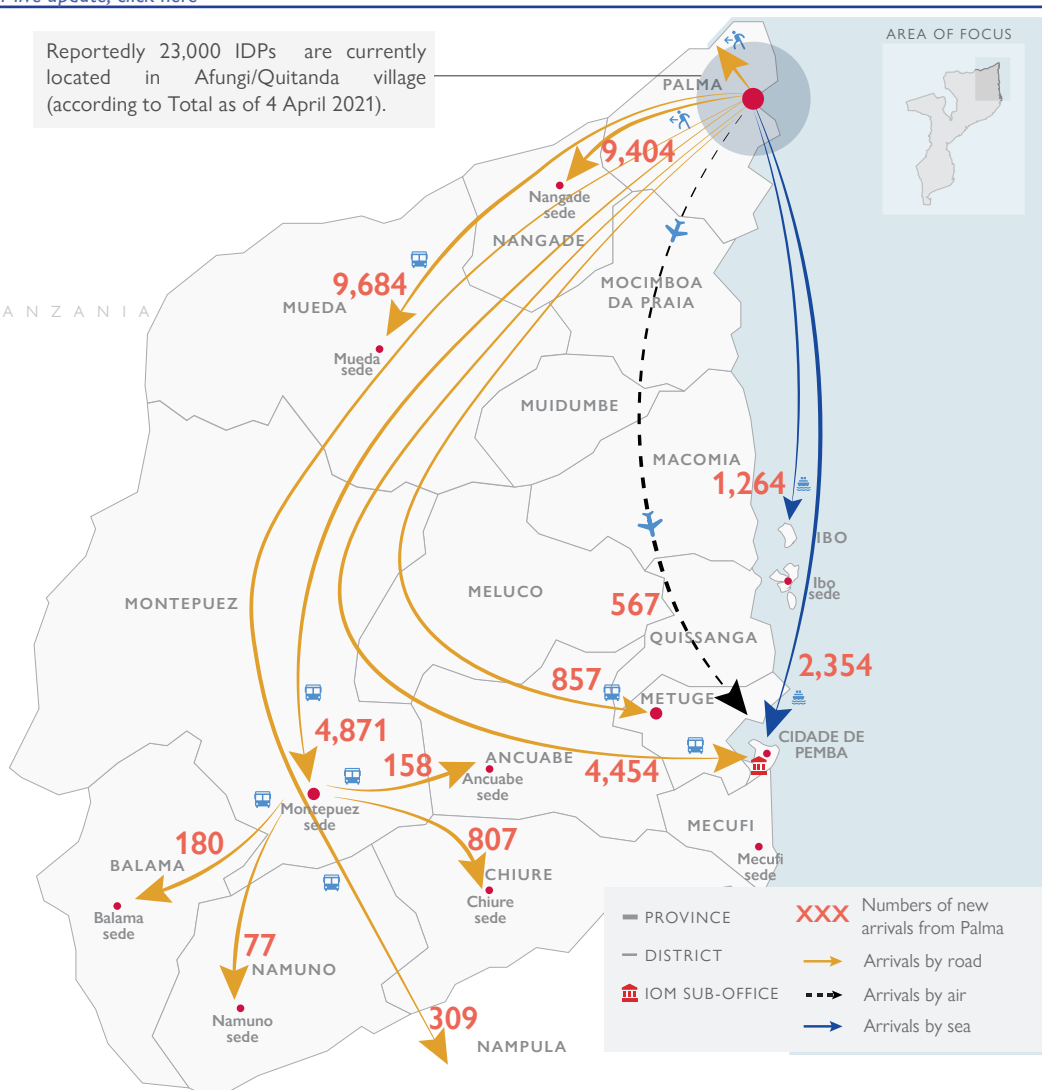
DTM Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is deployed to track and provide up-to-date information on sudden displacement and other population movements

ETT Report: No. 69/ 27 March - 02 May 2021 18:00h

Following the recent attacks in Palma Sede, DTM teams in Nangade, Mueda, Montepuez, and Pemba districts continue to register significant rise in IDP arrivals since 27 March. On the 2nd of May 2021, an estimated number of 2,087 IDPs were registered in the receiving districts bringing the total number of IDPs to 35,370 people who have been displaced from Palma. IDPs continue to arrive in Nangade on foot and by bus from Nangade to Mueda, Montepuez, and Pemba. Boat arrivals were reported in Paquitequete (Pemba), and in Matemo island (Ibo district), where 1,061 IDPs individuals arrived in 10 boats.

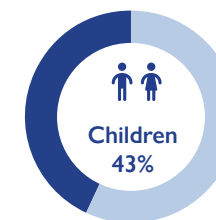
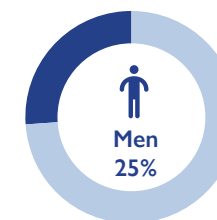
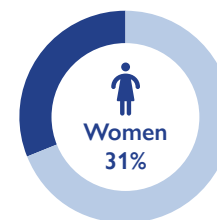

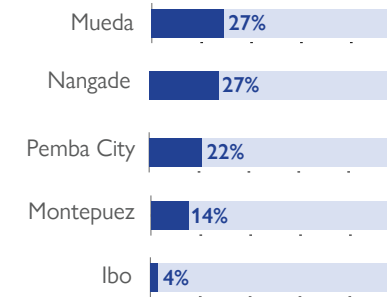

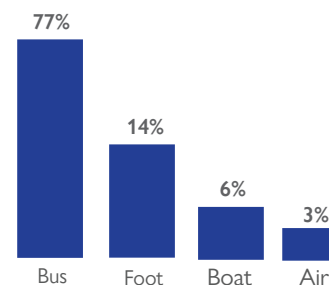
MAIN REPORTED NEEDS



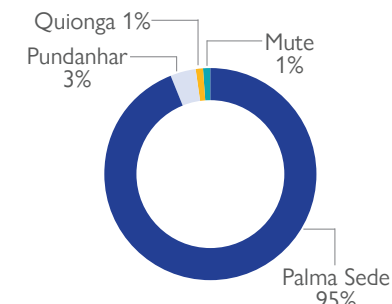
MAIN ARRIVAL DISTRICTS

LOCALITY OF ORIGIN



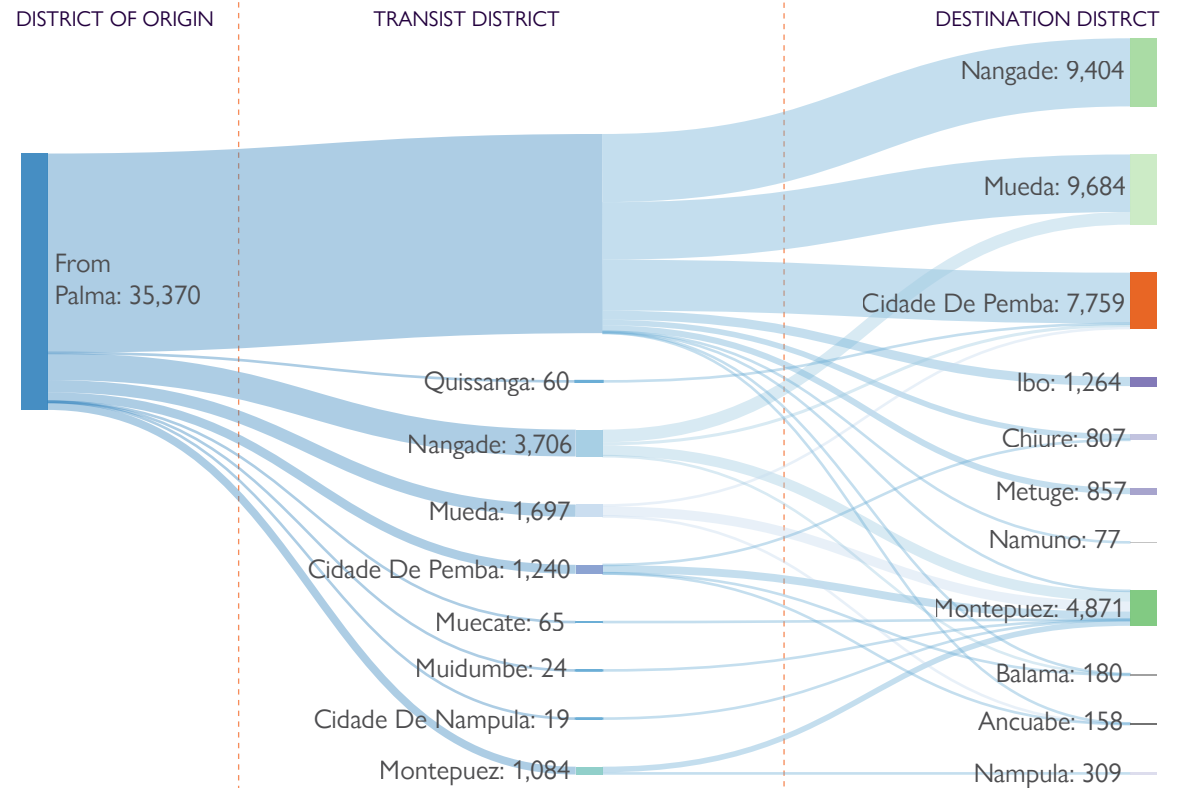
ABOUT THE EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements, and to provide support to the Government and the humanitarian community by disseminating data on IDPs for ensuring effective humanitarian response to the affected population. Emergency tracking teams and enumerators are deployed to Cidade de Pemba, Mueda, Meluco, Nangade, Montepuez, Ancuabe, Namuno, Balama, Chiure, Ibo, Metuge and Mecufi districts to collect data on displacement movements on a daily basis.
