



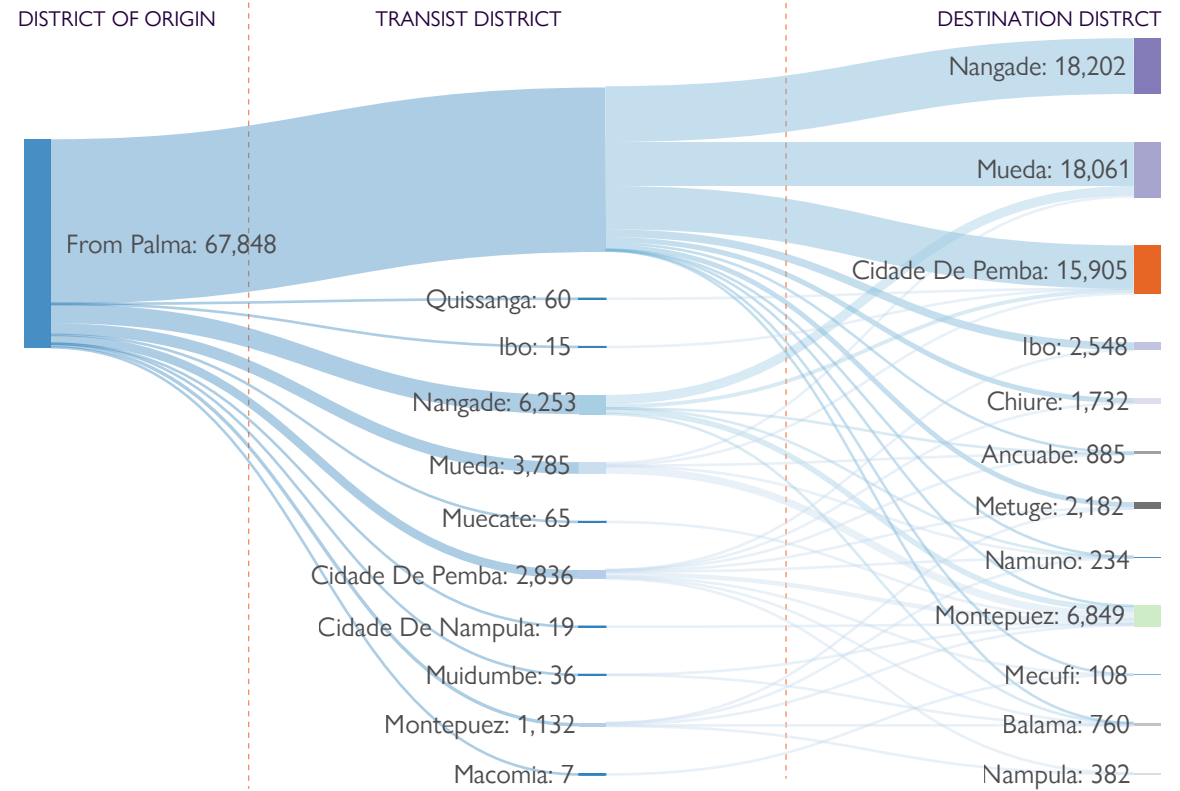
## ABOUT THE EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements, and to provide support to the Government and the humanitarian community by disseminating data on IDPs for ensuring effective humanitarian response to the affected population. Emergency tracking teams and enumerators are deployed to Cidade de Pemba, Mueda, Nangade, Montepuez, Ancuabe, Namuno, Balama, Chiure, Ibo, Metuge and Mecufi districts to collect data on displacement movements on a daily basis.
