

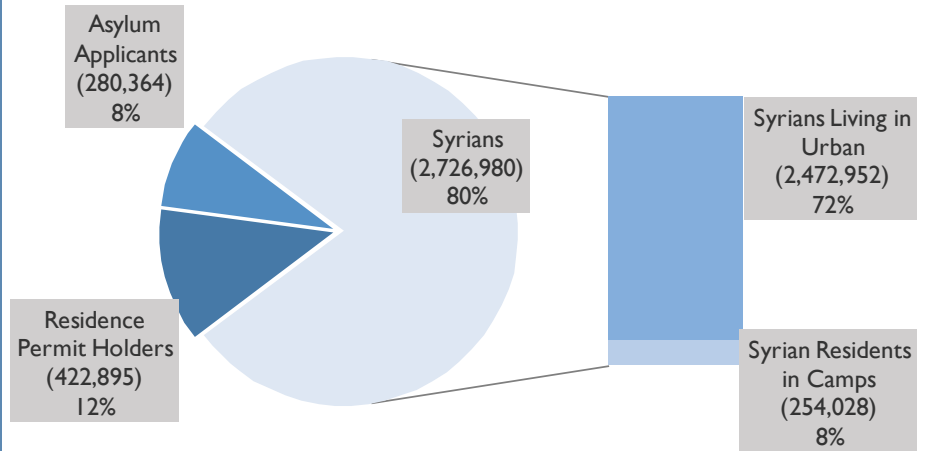
OVERVIEW OF MIGRANT SITUATION IN TURKEY

According to the latest available figures from the Turkish Directorate General for Migration Management (DGMM) currently there are approximately **3, 1 million foreign nationals** present in Turkish territory seeking for the international protection. Most of them are Syrians 2,726,980 who are granted with the temporary protection status, while according to UNHCR another greater group of the foreign nationals requiring Turkish humanitarian and legal protection are 280,364 asylum applicants consisting of different nationalities, but mainly coming from Iraq, Afghanistan, Iran, Somalia and other countries.

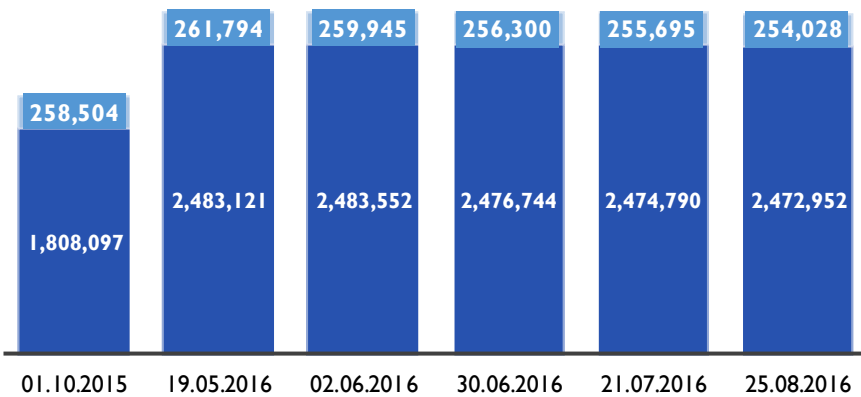
In addition, there are 422.895 foreign nationals under residency permit status including humanitarian residence holders.

TEMPORARY PROTECTION

Turkey implements a **Temporary Protection regime** for 2,726,980 refugees from Syria which grants beneficiaries right to legal stay as well as some level of access to basic rights and services. A vast majority of them 2,472,952 million, live outside the camps and are spread across the Turkish border provinces while nearly 254,028 live in 26 camps also close to the border with Syria.

ASYLUM APPLICANTS

Another greater group of the foreign nationals requiring international protection in Turkey are 280,364 **asylum applicants** consisting of different nationalities, but mainly coming from Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq, Somalia and other countries. *Data Source UNHCR, August 2016.

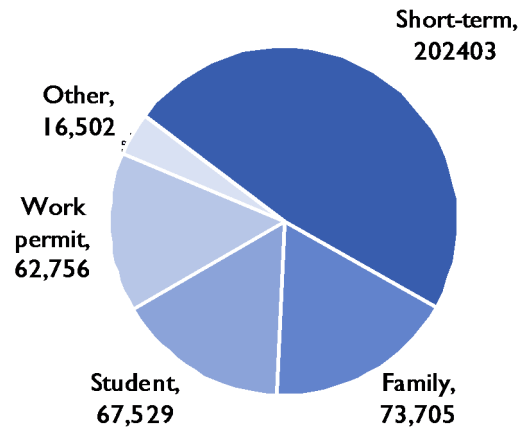

RESIDENCE PERMIT HOLDERS

Foreigners who would stay in Turkey beyond the duration of a visa or a visa exemption or, longer than ninety days should obtain a residence permit. There are 422.895 residence permit holders in Turkey within various categories of the residence permit. The residence permit include Humanitarian Residence permit holders but the exact number is unknown. It is believed that vast majority of this category are Iraqi nationals.

APPREHENDED/RESCUED MIGRANTS

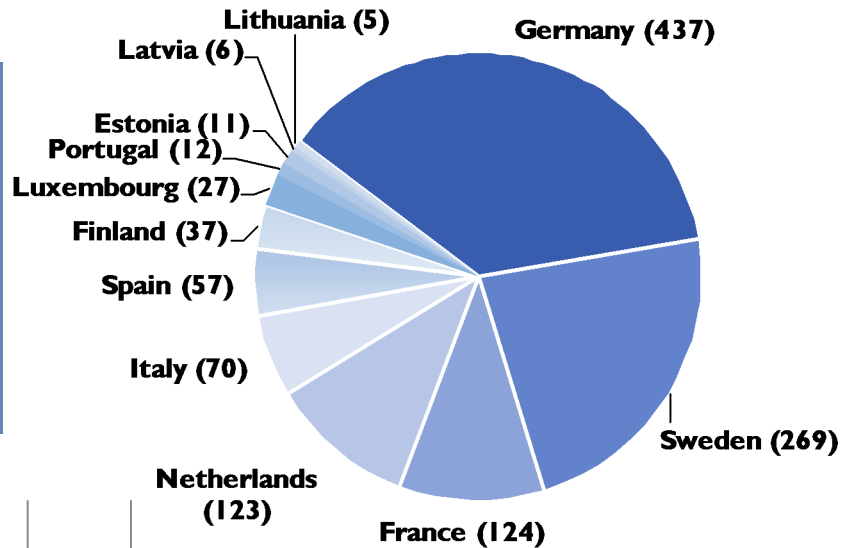
According to Turkish Coast Guard (TCG) Reports as of 30 August 2016, the Turkish Coast Guard has apprehended 28,632 irregular migrants and has registered 174 fatalities between 04 January and 30 August 2016.

READMITTED MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES TO TURKEY UNDER EU-TURKEY AGREEMENT

Since 4 April, 2016 there are 484 migrants and refugees readmitted to Turkey from Greece. The main exit points in Greece include Lesvos, Chios, Kos and Samos and the main entry points to Turkey include Dikili, Çeşme, Güllük/Bodrum and Adana. (through the airport).

RESETTLEMENT OF SYRIANS FROM TURKEY UNDER ONE-TO-ONE AGREEMENT

Since April 4, a total number of 1178 Syrians were resettled to the above mentioned countries according to One-to-One agreement with the assistance of IOM.
