

Flow Monitoring Points | Migrant Arrivals and Yemeni Returns from Saudi Arabia in January 2020



The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) monitors key migrant arrival and Yemeni return locations on Yemen's northern border with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) and southern coastal border. Enumerators placed at Flow Monitoring Points (FMPs) record arrivals of migranCts and Yemeni nationals' returns in order to identify different patterns and types of migration, including quantitative estimates to help define the population of irregular migrants entering the country. Access constraints limit the ability to collect data at some migrant arrival points. IOM estimates that 11,101 migrants entered Yemen in addition to 3,202 Yemeni returns from KSA during January 2020.




Migrants by Country of Intended Destination Migrants by Country of Departure




